1. Regional needs for medical personnel

In order to attract young medical specialists to the regions of the republic, on April 30, 2021, the I. K. Akhunbaev KSMA hosted an online meeting of graduates of the 2021 residency program with representatives of the Ministry of Health of the Kyrgyz Republic, the Rector's Office of the I. K. Akhunbaev KSMA and regional health coordinators, as well as the directors of FMC, TB and GMPC.

The meeting was attended by the representatives of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Kyrgyz Republic: Head of HRM Boobekova A. A., senior specialist of HRM Kerimbaeva I. M., Acting Rector of KSMA prof. Sopuev A. A., Dean FPME Prof. Salibaev O. A. and the faculty of KSMA.

Regional health coordinators and directors of TB, FMC, and GMPC participated from the regions of the PRK.

Today, the republic has an acute shortage of medical personnel in the regions. As of April 30, 2021, there are not enough medical personnel in the regions:

- in Batken region-76
- in the Jalal-Abad region 207
- in the Talas region-124
- in Osh region-166
- in Naryn region-134
- in Issyk-Kul region 232
- in the Chui region-175

At the meeting, the problems of distribution and consolidation of young specialists in the regions of the Kyrgyz Republic were considered.

The graduates were addressed by employers with proposals for the employment of graduates. They noted the good work for university graduates and expressed gratitude to the administration and staff of the university.

According to all participants, the fair was a success, and many positive responses were received on the organization and holding of this event. This is reflected in the fact that here the problem of employment is solved on the basis of direct contact between potential employers and young professionals.

Following the results of the job fair, KSMA graduates received an invitation to employment opportunities in the regions.
